### 1. Deposit - Deadline: December 12 (Friday), 2008

Your registration will be completed once we receive your deposit payment. Registrations will be handled on **a first-paid**, **first-serve basis**. Please pay your non-refundable deposit of \$300 by the deadline. As for payment methods, we will inform applicants by e-mail.

### 2. Air Ticket

You are responsible for booking your round-trip flights to Japan (Intl. Air Ticket). Information and recommendations on air ticket will be provided later on. Although we strongly recommend you to stay in Japan until the last day, it is possible to make special arrangements under extreme circumstances. Please contact us as soon as possible. Also, if you are planning on flying to Japan from outside of Boston, please let us know.

### 3. VISA

U.S. and Canadian citizens do not need a VISA to travel to Japan, but some certain nationalities need a VISA\*. Please check the **Ministry of Foreign Affair**'s website (<a href="http://www.mofa.go.jp/i\_info/visit/visa/02.html">http://www.mofa.go.jp/i\_info/visit/visa/02.html</a>) for VISA Exemption countries.

#### 4. Insurance

Students at HSPH and BUSPH are not covered by university health insurance plan. It is your responsibility to sign up for a travel insurance plan provided by insurance companies. Your safety is our priority; you are strongly recommended to be properly insured.

### 5. Immunization
